The Director

Vicky Tan Warkentien is professor of Music at Bethel University, where her work includes directing the Chamber Orchestra, Concert Choir and Chamber Ensembles. She also teaches courses in conducting, music theory, sight-singing and ear-training, and piano pedagogy.

Dr. Warkentien holds the Bachelor of Music degree in Piano Performance from San Francisco State University, the Master of Church Music degree in Choral Conducting and Piano Performance, and the Doctor of Music Ministry degree in Conducting, Piano Performance and Music Ministry from the Southern Baptist Theological Seminary.

Dr. Warkentien has maintained an active role as Director of Choral Music at Clay Methodist Church and Michiana Chinese Christian Church. As the Executive Director of the World Association for Chinese Church Music, she frequently collaborates with Chinese churches and seminaries in conducting worship and music trainings in the United States, Canada, Australia, New Zealand, and Asia.
